



Blackout on February 13, 2009

On Friday, February 13, 2009 the Public Employees Pension Plan (PEPP) will enter a planned blackout period. This blackout is due to an enhancement and relocation of the PEBA Information Technology (IT) servers. The system enhancements will benefit PEBA staff and PEPP members.

All transactions will be suspended for that day. Unit values will be posted to the website on Thursday February 12, 2009 but will not be declared for Friday February 13.

A planned blackout occurs to ensure the integrity of member records and accounts during the IT enhancement.

No e-mail will be able to be received or sent at the Public Employees Benefits Agency (PEBA). PEPP staff will not have access to operating systems or local area network drives. Pension and benefit administration systems and retirement planners will not be available

Every effort will be made to keep the PEPP website available to members but the functionality will be limited.

Please notify your plan members of the blackout.

PEPP anticipates returning to normal processing February 17, 2009. Any requests received during a blackout period will be processed as soon as possible starting the first business day after the blackout period has ended. At that time, we will clear any processing backlog in order of date received.
