

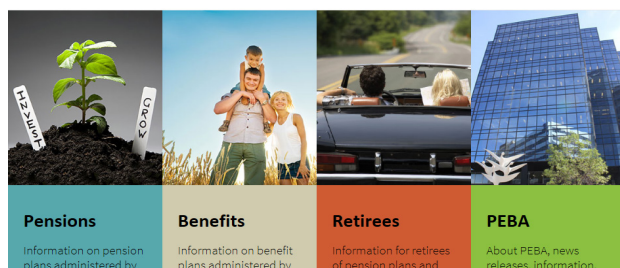

### 2015 Maximum Contribution Limits

The 2015 maximum pension contribution limit is the **lesser of** 18% (of your employee's annual income) **or** \$25,370. This limit applies to the total of all employee, employer and voluntary contributions received by PEPP. Transfers of RRSPs or other pension into PEPP are not included in the limit. Please monitor these limits as you may be charged a processing fee for the payment of excess contributions to ensure compliance with the Income Tax Act (ITA).
