

## **Appendix II - Status Report of the Recommendations from the 2015 Review**

## **Status report on the recommendations contained in the 2015 Croll Report on its review of the Composition of the Municipal Employees' Pension Commission.**

The last review was undertaken in 2015 and the Croll Report contained seven recommendations:

- That MEPP legislation be amended to:
  - allow for an additional trustee to be appointed by the employers of firefighters and police;
  - allow for an additional trustee to be appointed by the Canadian Union of Public Employees(CUPE) ;
  - amend the current trade union appointed trustee to be appointed by the remaining appointing bodies once CUPE is removed in consideration of the appointment above; and
  - provide for the election of a chair and a vice-chair for a term of two years from one year;
- That the Regional Colleges and Regional Libraries develop a Memorandum of Understanding to guide matters related to their shared seat on MEPC;
- That the Commission provide facilitation services for the negotiations referenced in the above recommendation if such is requested by the parties; and
- That the Commission develop a list of 'considerations' or a desired 'skills matrix' to help nominating organizations with the recruitment and selection of nominees to MEPC.

The first four recommendations were directed at the Government of Saskatchewan and the Government accepted all four recommendations. The other three recommendations were directed to the Commission.

All seven recommendations have been instituted, most notably increasing the size of the Commission to 12 trustees.
